

Maine Amateur Hockey Association (MeAHA) Leagues  
2011-2012 Season

**Tier II Division – Zone Based**

Bantam Each Zone will roster a team comprised of either first or second year bantam players. Each team will schedule three home and three away games against each opponent within this league for a total of 24 regular season games. Primarily, Games should occur on Sundays. League standings and game reporting will be monitored on the MeAHA Website.

Peewee Each Zone will roster one Peewee team comprised of either first or second year peewee players. Each team will schedule three home and three away games against each opponent within this league for a total of 24 regular season games. League standings and game reporting will be monitored on the MeAHA Website.

Squirt Each Zone will roster one Squirt team comprised of either first or second year squirt players. Each Team will schedule three home and three away games against each opponent within this league for a total of 24 regular season games. League standings and game reporting will be monitored on the MeAHA Website.

**Guidelines for team formation:**

- All skaters within the zone interested in participating in either the Tier 2 or Tier 3 teams are required to participate in the Tier 2 tryout process.
- It is recommended that each zone select 15 Skaters and 2 goalies for the Tier 2 team, however smaller rosters are allowed.
- If a participant declines the position on the Tier 2 team, that player will not be allowed to participate in the Tier 3 team and will revert to the Tier 4 level of play.
- Zones are allowed to Roster Tier 3 Goalies on both the Tier 2 & Tier 3 rosters to account for injury or illness of the Tier 2 Goalie/Goalies. Tier 2 Goalies are only allowed on the Tier 2 Roster (No playing Down)

**Transfer of Players from One Zone to another:**

Players may tryout for and participate in either the Tier 2 or Tier 3 team of the Zone with which they participated in during the 2009-2010 Season. The player must have a valid transfer on File with MeAHA demonstrating the transfer occurred prior to 2/1/10. Starting 2/2/10, players are not allowed to transfer from one zone to another to participate in either Tier 2 or Tier 3 unless their physical address changes.

**Tier 3 Division – Zone Based**

Bantam Each Zone will roster either one or two bantam teams comprised of either first or second year bantam players. Since the number of teams can vary from year to year, the number of home and away games scheduled will also vary. MeAHA will determine the appropriate numbers of home and away games to achieve approximately 25 games after teams are declared. League standings and game reporting will be monitored on the MeAHA Website.

League standings and game reporting will be monitored on the MeAHA Website.

**Guidelines for Team formation:**

- A participant in this division must have been considered for the Tier 2 team
- It is recommended that each zone select 15 Skaters and 2 goalies for each Tier 3 team, however smaller rosters are allowed
- Amount of teams participating from each zone at any particular level (Squirt/Peewee/Bantam) will be dependant on amount of skaters registered within that zone from the previous year regardless of level played. Each zone will only be allowed to enter a maximum of two teams per level.
- Qualification for entering the second team per level is as follows:
  - Squirts – The projected amount of skaters at the squirt level, based upon the previous years registration, will exceed **120 youth** skaters
  - Peewee - The projected amount of skaters at the peewee level, based upon the previous years registration, will exceed **120 youth** skaters
  - Bantams - The projected amount of skaters at the bantam level, based upon the previous years registration, will exceed **120 youth** skaters

**Transfer of Players from One Zone to another:**

Players may tryout for and participate in either the Tier 2 or Tier 3 team of the Zone with which they participated in during the 2009-2010 Season. The player must have a valid transfer on File with MeAHA demonstrating the transfer occurred prior to 2/1/10.

Starting 2/2/10, players are not allowed to transfer from one zone to another unless their physical address changes.
